Friday July 10th – Car Cruise and Lunch

9am – Departing the Grand Hotel with the assistance of the RCMP to get thru the lights and out of town.

Cruise to Barrington along the Hwy 103 with a quick “drive by” at the Nakile Seniors Home on the way. Three photographers will be riding along this year to take photos of us and/or our cars in front of the famous Lobster Statues - available for free online later that day.

We will get off the Hwy 103 at Exit 30 – approximately an hour drive

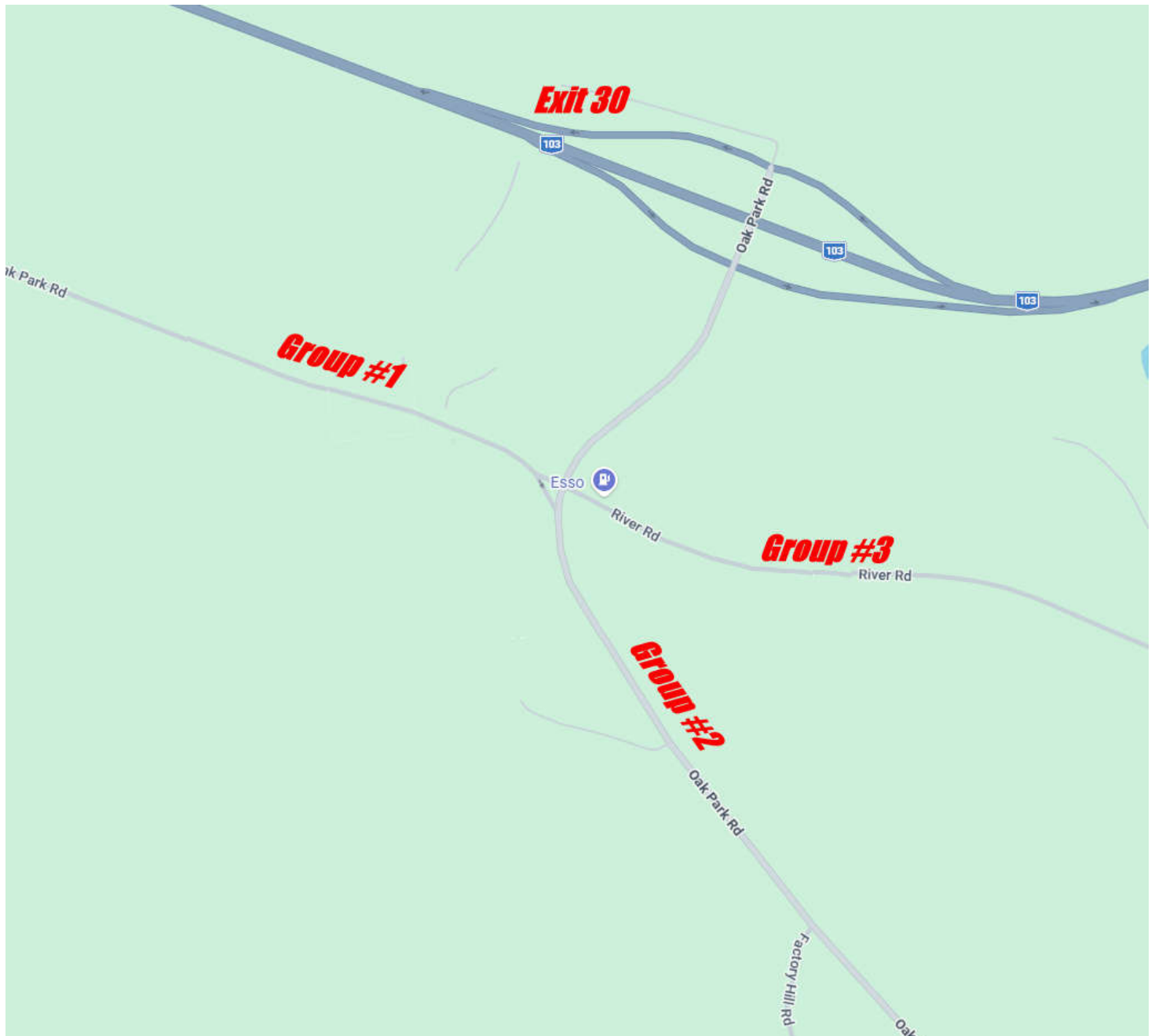


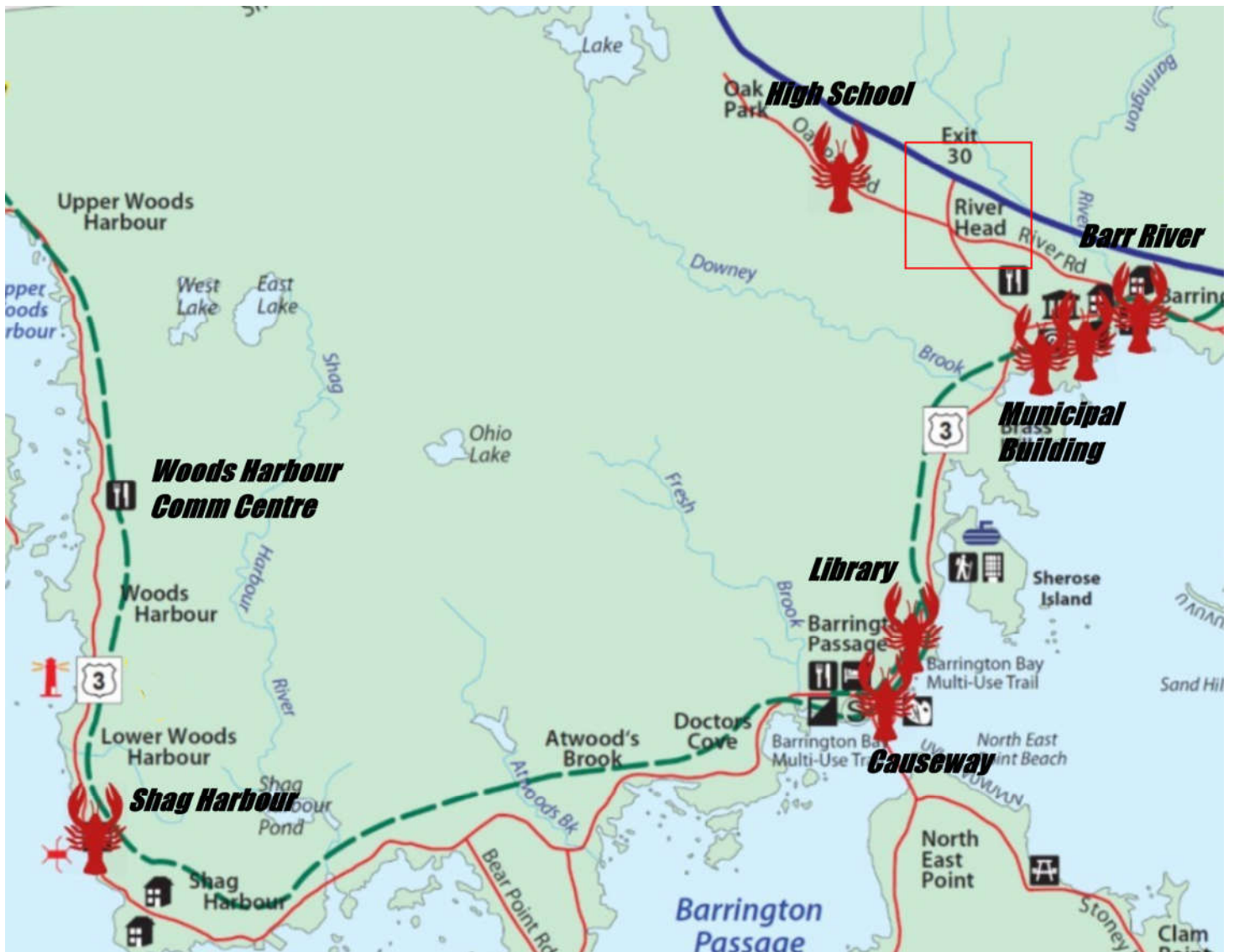

*Group #3 – head to Barrington River then Municipal building. Then to the High School. Then the Library and Causeway statues. Finally, on to Shag Harbour then the Woods Harbour Comm Center for lunch.





Lunch at the Comm Center should go much smoother than last year's restaurants. Especially since we will arrive in three groups. Everyone has pre-ordered their meal so all that's left is to enjoy 😊

After lunch, you can make your way back to Yarmouth.

Easiest route is to continue north from the Comm Center (turn left) and drive about 15mins to the Hwy 103 (take a right at the Petro Canada & left at the Hwy) and straight to Yarmouth

Boats depart together once everyone is aboard - cruise to Tusket Island Party.

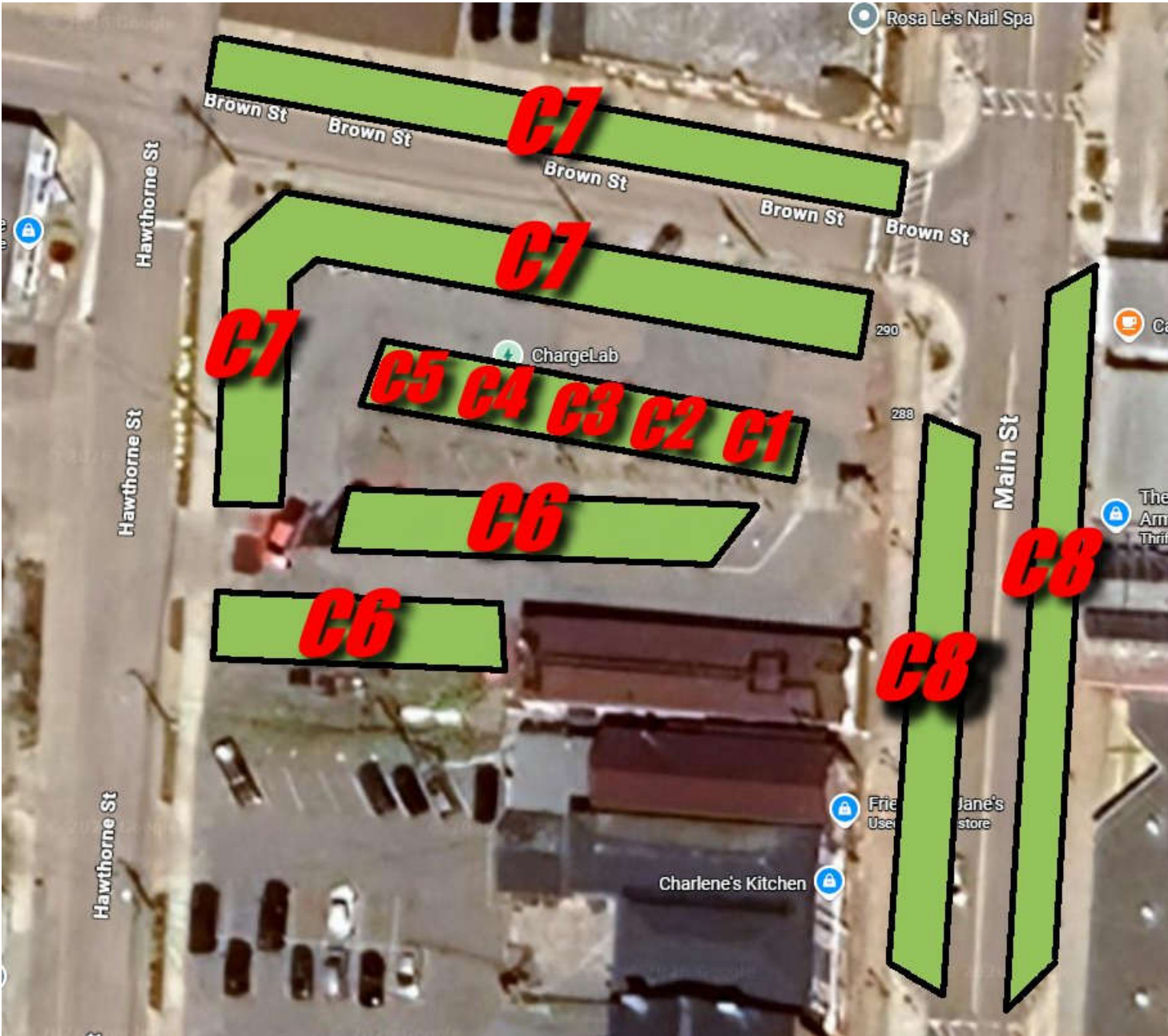
A selection of cold refreshments available on all 3 boats.

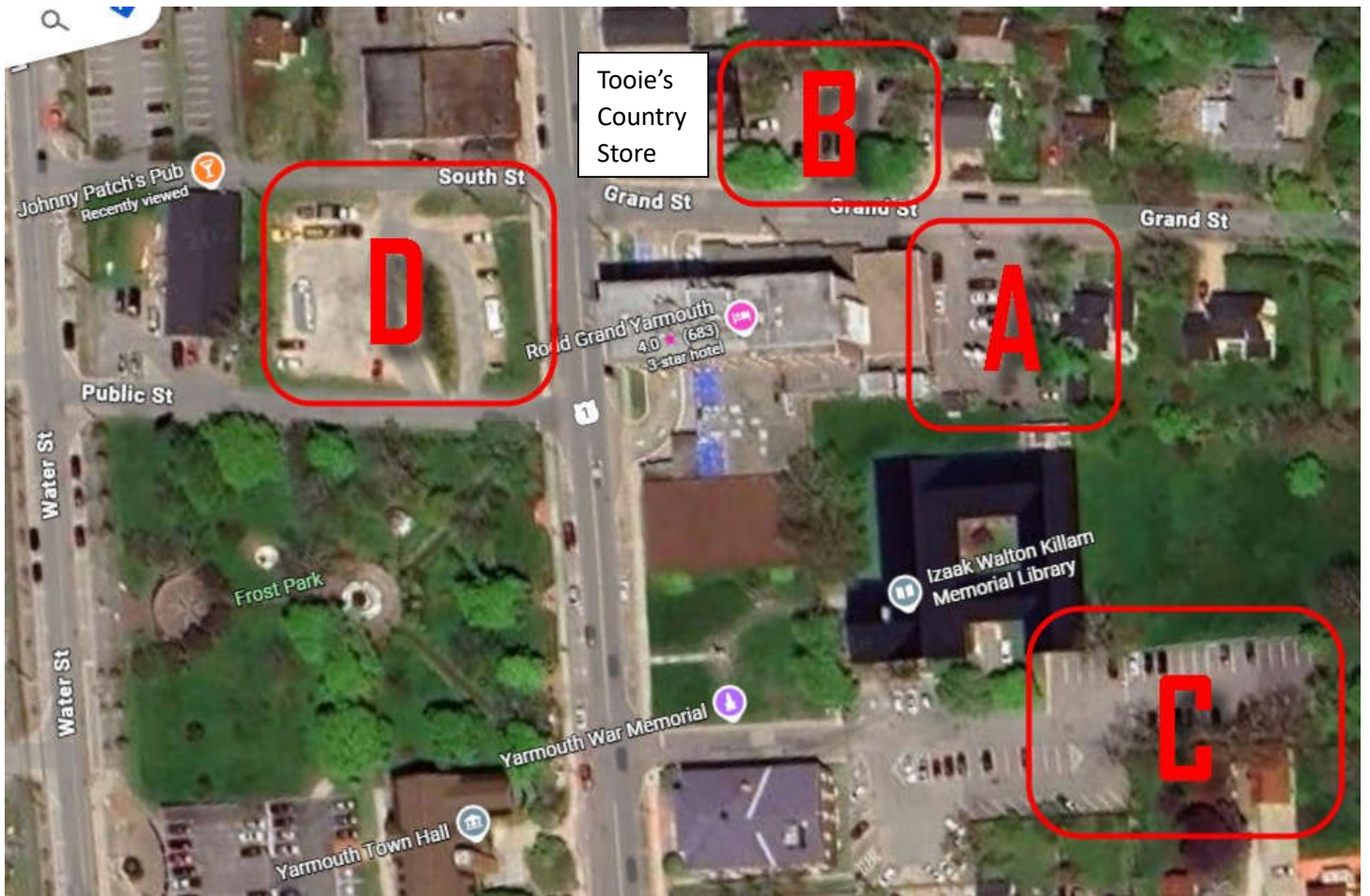

Parking C – Library parking

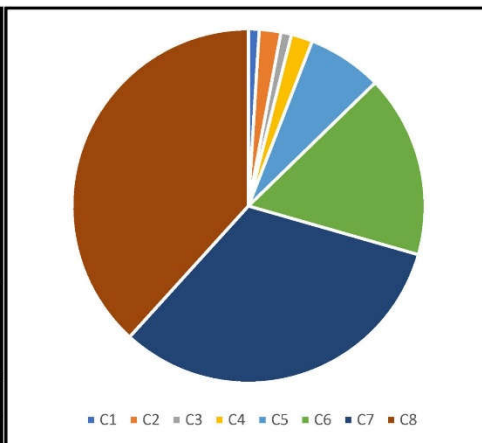
Parking D – Unpaved

NOTE: the parking lot at Toonie's Country Store is available after hours each evening.

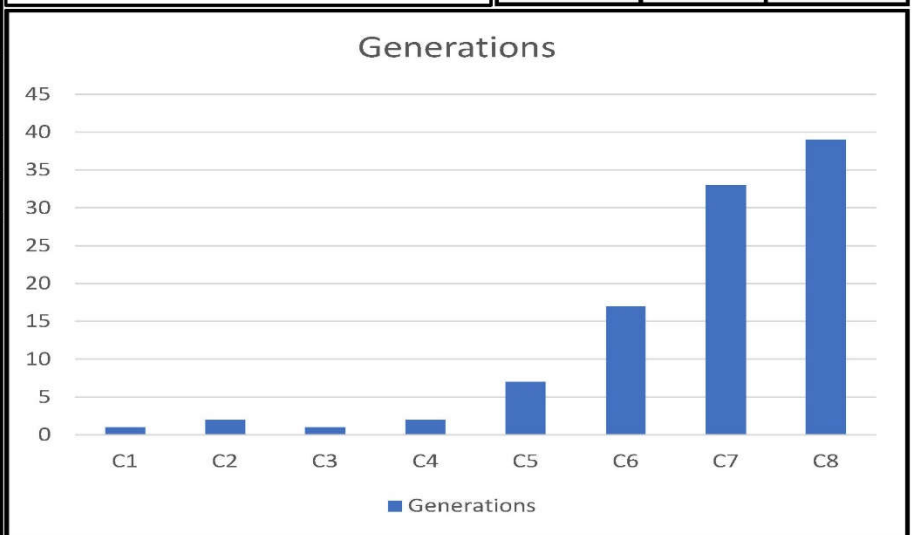
You can park in Lot D until the store closes
